OSHA Standards 1910.179 (Overhead & Gantry Cranes); 1910.1884 Slings; and ANSI B30.2-67 Safety Code for Overhead and Gantry Cranes.

Is there a preventative maintenance plan as per manufacturer's guidelines?			
Are alloy steel chains identified & labeled with their size, grade, rated capacity & reach?			
Are slings inspected for wear prior to use?
