Are signs removed within three (3) days after the REI has expired?				
Are decontamination supplies available? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decontamination supplies must be available for 30 days after application if the REI is longer than four (4) hours. • Decontamination supplies are only required for seven (7) days with pesticides with less than a four (4) hour REI.
