In lieu of a Material Safety Data Sheet the following information is being provided:

TSCA requires the following controls:

Health risk information must be provided by the following (or other effective) means:

All containers of this substance must be conspicuously labeled, written notices must be conspicuously placed in areas where exposure to this substance may occur, or written notices must be provided to each employee potentially exposed to this substance including but not limited to lab technicians, transporters, and disposal personnel.

Exposure to the substance must be controlled through the implementation of prudent laboratory practices for the handling of chemical substances of unknown toxicity:

Written laboratory protocols for the use of chemical substances of unknown toxicity must be included in the laboratory safety plan.

Designated areas for using chemical substances of unknown toxicity must be clearly delineated.

This substance must be used solely for research and development with the following restrictions and conditions:

The substance will not be redistributed except for disposal purposes and to other research laboratories upon agreement to this and the above conditions.
